

Eleven of us travelled to Lisbon last week to take part in the Pitch Beach tournament organised by the <u>Dark Horses</u>, Lisbon's gay rugby team, where we also competed against <u>Los Valents</u> de Montpellier. Friday – **Rugby 7's** (7 players on each side on a whole pitch, 2×7 minutes) Morning matches:

Afternoon matches:

- Dark Horses-Los Valents: DH win
- Dark Horses-Straffe Ketten: SK win
- Straffe Ketten-Los Valents: SK win

Total: SK 3, LV 2, DH 1! After that, we should have played a finale against Los Valents, but it was so hot (40°!) and everybody was so exhausted that the Montpellier guys preferred not to play that game, allowing us to claim victory based on the number of matches we'd won during the day. Saturday – **Beach rugby** (5 players on each side, 2×5 minutes on a smaller area... but in the sand!) Morning matches:

- Dark Horses-Los Valents: 1-1
- Dark Horses-Straffe Ketten: 2-1
- Straffe Ketten-Los Valents: 4-2

The programme also included afternoon matches, but by then Los Valents had to stop, due to too many injuries on their side. One of their members (Guirec) joined us. We played an epic finale against Dark Horses: Lisbon scored 3 tries in the first 3 minutes, which made us panic more than a little. Fortunately we recovered, and managed to come back into the game, with a final score of 4-4. Lisbon won the day, as they hadn't lost any match in the morning: DH 1st, SK 2nd, LV 3rd.

Because Lisbon ended 3rd on the first day, while we ended 2nd on the second day, we won the tournament — even though, when handing the trophies, Filipe of the Dark Horses later pointed out that the goal wasn't

about competing, but about having a good time... we totally agree, but we still won 🥹
